The club has 2 welfare officers with the designated responsibility for safeguarding, supporting child-centred practice and ensuring that safeguarding arrangements are in place and are adhered to in the club. Welfare officers work closely with management and staff and ensure that all staff and volunteers are updated on any changes in Child Protection laws or legislation and/or changes to British Gymnastics Policies.

All safeguarding concerns reported to or by staff/ volunteers will be logged and filed securely in line with the Data Privacy Notice.
